Basant Panchmi CELEBRATION

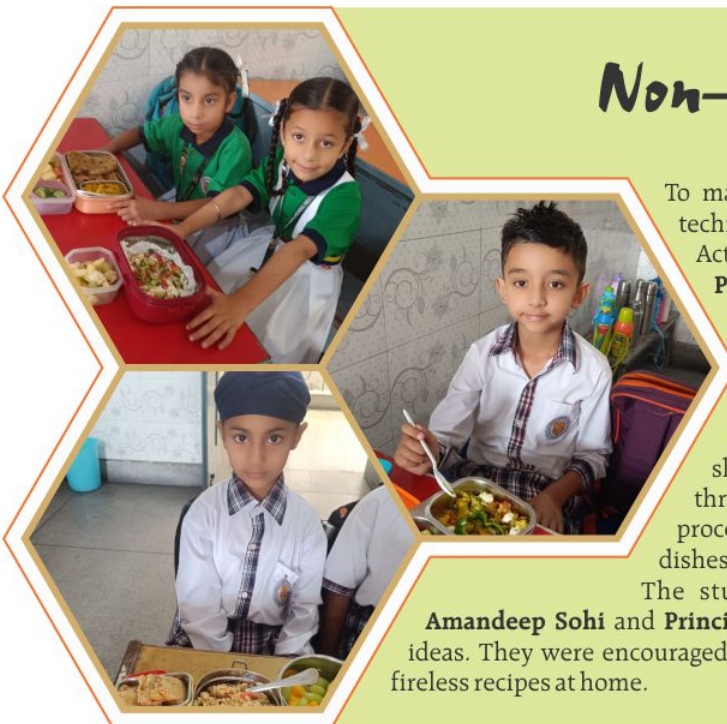

Seminar on Mental Health and Stress Management

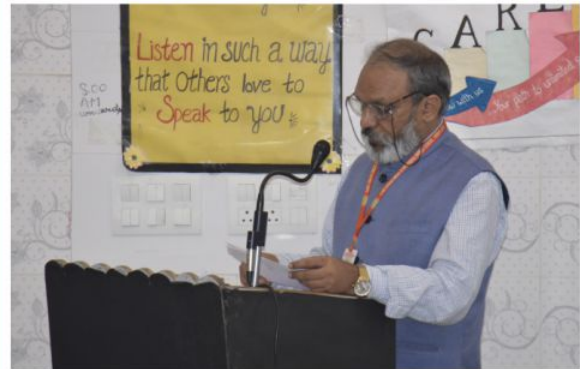
Seminars on Career Guidance
